What is She Nailed It!?

This is an all women, nail-hammering, beat-the-clock competition to raise money for Nassau Habitat. Teams consist of four women, four nails, one board and one hammer. After team member 1 starts the clock and hammers her nail flush with the board, the hammer is passed to the next team member and so on. The last team member stops the time after her nailing is complete. Teams are looking to have the fastest time. Like a swim meet, there will be heats and rounds until there is a winner!

What's new this year?

- New venue
- Easier registration
- Online liability waivers
- No spectator admission fees
- Higher fundraising goals- Let's raise enough for an entire house!
- All nailers on same side of board (facing audience)

When and where is the event?

This year we will be hammering on the main stage at the Green Turtle Tavern (18 S. 3rd Street! Doors open at 2:00 PM- hammering starts at 3:00 PM

Who can compete?

Teams must consist of four women and can be sponsored by a company (\$1500 level or higher) or choose to be a grass roots team and raise a minimum of \$1,000 from friends and family.

How do I enter a team?

Team captains complete a registration form (visit www.nassauHabitatFL.com) listing their team members, t-shirt size and contact information. Come up with a clever name or theme to add to the fun.

Do our goals have to be met before we register our team?

No. In fact, once you register your team, fundraising teams are invited to join our Give Lively donor platform. Your team will have its own team fundraising page, with a donation link to send to friends and family and coworkers. Goals must be met by Oct 15, 2024 or risk losing your spot in the competition. All teams on Give Lively will be eligible to win the coveted "Most Funds Raised" award.

Are there any practice sessions?

Yes! There will be several practice sessions in the days and weeks before the event. Habitat regulars will be on hand to give you some pointers.

What about safety?

All participants are asked to sign a liability waiver that covers the She Nailed It! competition, all practice sessions, and volunteering at a Nassau Habitat build. Close toed shoes and protective eyewear are also required. Safety glasses will be provided.

Can I bring my own hammer?

Nope. We will provide hammers and nails for each practice session and for the competition. No nail guns- **Hear that Pirates?**
